- Priority will be given to those pursuing a career in automobile technical skills or collision repair. **By definition, we mean individuals who wish to make a career out of fixing, restoring and maintaining automobiles.**
- Employees of H&H Chevrolet, their family members or employees of companies doing business with H&H Chevrolet are **not** eligible.

1. One character reference letter (For example, a letter from a teacher or employer who is familiar with your capabilities and interests in this field.)
2. An outline of:
  - a. educational activities and honors
  - b. community and/or volunteer activities
  - c. extracurricular activities
  - d. work experience
3. Summary of extracurricular activities in the automotive field, if any. (Work experience, hobbies, etc.)
4. A transcript of your high school grades.
5. A paragraph about why you are pursuing a career in the automotive field.
